

List of the micro projects funded by EPF's Youth Banks in Georgia

Funded in November 2008 to be completed by April 2009

Initiatives funded by the Batumi Youth Bank:

1. *Football Tournament*: to organize a football tournament between the two public schools and three schools for students with special needs in Batumi; 424 USD
2. *Help to Orphans*: to organize charitable action to mobilize community resources to help children of Batumi orphanage with food and hygiene materials; 397 USD
3. *Intellectual Games*: to support members of the intellectual club at the Kobuleti Public School to purchase books to encourage their intellectual development; 423.20 USD
4. *Intellectual Games for Kindergarteners*: to help the kindergarten with books and visual aids to support their intellectual development; 297 USD

Initiatives funded by the Marneuli Youth Bank:

1. *Fun Sport Games*: to organize sports competition between four public schools in Marneuli District; 393.18 USD
2. *Protect Nature*: to mobilize the local community to clean the central street and park in the town of Marneuli; 406.67 USD
3. *Me and the Environment*: to organize training of students of Marneuli public schools; 419.21 USD
4. *Volleyball*: to organize a volleyball tournament to involve both girls and boys in sports; 89.70 USD
5. *Chess Championship*: to popularize chess for the intellectual development of youth in Marneuli; 337.27 USD

Initiatives funded by the Akhaltsikhe Youth Bank:

1. *Everlasting Art*: to organize a charitable action to help the Akhaltsikhe Orphanage. Akhaltsikhe State University students will weave and sew handmade clothes to be sold at an exhibition. Money received from the sale of these clothes will be used to buy school supplies for the children of Akhaltsikhe Orphanage. 485 USD
2. *Clean and Comfortable School Yard*: to clean the territory of Akhaltsikhe Public School # 1, which has been used by the local population as a garbage dump and establish plant garden there. 481 USD
3. *Books First of All*: to purchase books for the library at Akhaltsikhe Public School # 1 and organize intellectual competition for the school students. 483 USD

Initiatives funded by the Zugdidi Youth Bank:

1. *Healthy Environment for Future Generations*: to clean the territory of the public school in the village of Jvari, Tsalenjikha District, which has been used by the local population as a garbage dump. 425 USD

2. *Theatre against War*: to develop a pantomime theatre performance called “NO WAR,” by Zugdidi Public School # 2 initiative group to emphasize the positive results of non-violent ways of resolution of conflict for Zugdidi public. 464 USD
3. *Source of Knowledge*: to purchase books for the school library to help IDP students (who constitute 20% of the total number of students) to have better access to extracurricular literature. 182 USD
